Later in November two more articles will be published and thus we will have reached 50 articles translated into the Romanian language and distributed in Romania and abroad. The articles have been translated with the support of Sallux– ECPM Foundation and they present theological reflections on a range of topics, to help Christians shape their thinking and work.

Urgent repairs needed

We are grateful for the investment we can make in the people we serve and we are so excited to see the outcome of our programs in their lives. As you probably remember, we had to do major repairs to the building to be able to renew our license for social projects. We had to repaint all the offices, put fireproof doors at the entrance to the library and reseal some walls affected by mold and moisture.

However, our problems have not been entirely solved and we need to change the roof of the old building, as when there is heavy rain, the water infiltrates inside the building. We need to change the slope of the roof and replace some of the old tiles.

We have received an estimation of the total cost, which is 4,000 EUR. For us this is a lot of money and we do not have it right now. Education for disadvantaged children

As you know from our previous newsletters, we have continued all our social programmes during the pandemic, however, the educational programme for children coming from poor families with a high risk of

dropping out of school was mainly in an online format. Starting this past October, children have been able to come in person for classes. Our volunteer tutors from the West University of Timisoara help improve their school performances so they can pass each grade successfully and reduce the risk of abandoning school. Their parents, as well as their school teachers, are impressed with their improvements and very much appreciate our efforts.

So far, we have 22 children enrolled in this programme and 19 tutors.



In addition to the free tutoring, occasionally they receive snacks or a bag of food for their families. Once a month they meet for extra-curriculum activities, such as crafts, board games, various trainings, etc.
